Subject: Competition for the academic position of "Associate Professor"
in the field of higher education 9. Security and Defense,
professional field 9.1 "National Security"
("Migration processes and risks for national security"
(In the context of cybersecurity and information

1. Information about the competition

The competition is announced by the "Academy of National and Information Security." I participate in the scientific jury of the competition, in accordance with Order No. 105/05.01.2026 of the Rector of ANIS.

2. Information about the candidates in the competition

The candidate in the competition for the academic position of "associate professor" Dr. Miloš Svrček on 30.01.2009 received the "doctor prav" (JURr.), on 27.08.2021 he graduated with a degree in "Master of Political Science" at the University "Alexander Dupček", in Trenčín, Slovakia, on 06.06.2025 he graduated with a "Master of Science", PPA Business School and "University of Security

Management", received the degree "doctor" on 25.10.2013, at the "Paneuropska Vysoka Skola", Faculty of Law, Republic of Slovenia.

3. Fulfillment of the requirements for holding the academic position

From the data presented in the table for the fulfillment of "Minimum required points by group indicators for the academic position "associate professor", it is evident that the candidate has 525 points out of the required 400, which means that he meets the requirements.

4. Assessment of teaching and learning activities

The candidate is a university lecturer at the Department of "Security Sciences", at the "University of Security Management" in Košice from 01.09.2024 to the present, in Slovakia. He teaches the subjects: environmental law, constitutional law, jurisprudence, political science, security.

He evaluates students' written works, processes materials for electronic courses and consults on diploma theses, supervises diploma theses (bachelor's and master's theses). These data are presented with the candidate's CV. They do not allow the candidate's pedagogical training to be assessed. To do this, it is necessary:

1. The candidate must submit a report on his academic workload for the specified period of teaching activity.

5. General characteristics of the submitted scientific works/publications

The candidate has submitted for participation in the competition for review 1 (one) monograph - habilitation work of 304 pages, 1 (one) monograph, which is not submitted for the main habilitation work, 252 pages, a book published on the basis of the dissertation work for the acquisition of the ONS "doctor", 368 pages.

Articles and reports published in non-refereed journals with scientific review or published in edited collective volumes, a total of 18 pieces. Of these, I accept 15 pieces for review. I do not accept the following articles for review:

p) SVRČEK, M.: Legislative and institutional instruments of the European Union for strengthening environmental security.

r) SVRČEK, M., MOLNAR.N.: *Implementation of environmental responsibility through legal means of the European Union.*

s) MOLNAR, N., SVRČEK, M.: *Cybersecurity in modern cars: challenges, threats and protection perspectives.*

Reason: The number of pages for each article/publication is not specified. In this case, the total number of points for the candidate should be reduced by 15 points.

The 15 articles/publications accepted for review are 165 pages long. Together with the two monographs and the book, the pages for review are 1089 pages. This shows good publication activity of the candidate.

5.1. Assessment of monographs as an independent subject of review

In his habilitation work "Terrorism as a consequence of international migrations", the candidate analyzes the social consequences of their relationship with the security of the state. He makes a retrospective comparative analysis of the nature of migration in the past centuries of humanity, deduces two important hypotheses: one is that then it had a positive influence as progress and assistance for developing countries, and the other - for modern migration is that it is a phenomenon of fear and fright for developed countries. From them arises the main goal of the habilitation monograph to prove these hypotheses and indicate the reasons for this.

The author brings out the reason that the pursuit of capital/wealth is often disguised by the protection of human rights and the right to democracy. The aim is to note that behind everything lies the mineral wealth of the respective countries and the inability to dispose of it and utilize it separately. The offer of new technologies creates additional dependence on the so-called "big brothers", who imperceptibly impose their way of life and are not ashamed to call it democracy. The monograph argues the thesis of exporting democracy and inserting it into the internal affairs of states by introducing various groups that have their own internal order and goals.

The monograph focuses on human rights, migration and the terrorism resulting from it. It is worth noting that ultimately security education can be a reliable barrier to protect all people.

The monograph “Fundamentals of Political Science in Governance and Security Practice” examines the problems of achieving stability and the associated security for the development of society. A mandatory condition for establishing a rule of law is the democratic acquisition of political power through elections associated with universal suffrage. Based on the results of the elections, political parties with different orientations enter the parliament, so the leaders of individual parties must be able to reach a consensus, which is a prerequisite for the functioning of the parliament and the formation of a government. An important fact is the influence of parliamentarism on security in the state.

The rule of law and social agreement-consensus are analyzed. Ignoring the demands of minorities can lead to increased tension in society, which reduces the level of its security and stability.

The nation's own interests are taken into account, which can become the subject of disputes in international integrations, which on the one hand can provide economic benefits, but also limit some national interests. The current problems of the search for consensus, aimed at democratic and rational articulation of national identity and integration in the interests of security and development of nations, are studied.

5.2. Scientific and applied scientific results

I accept the presented scientific contributions of the candidate specified in points 1-3 and his applied scientific contributions specified in point 4 of the document signed by him entitled: "Scientific and applied contributions of scientific production."

Within the framework of my competences, I have no grounds for finding plagiarism.

6. Critical notes and recommendations

I recommend that the candidate in the future apply even more in-depth knowledge of the general theory of security of social organization in his research.

When presenting his scientific and applied contributions, he should indicate in which of his works each contribution was made.

7. Conclusion

The candidate meets the requirements for holding the competitive academic position of "associate professor", defined in Art. 53 of the PPZRASRB and the references under Art. 54, para. 1. This gives me reason to give an overall positive assessment.

In accordance with Art. 57 of the PPZRASRB, taking into account the indicators related to the expert and research activities of the candidate, I vote positively for the election of **Dr. Miloš Svrček** to hold the academic position of "associate professor" in the field of higher education 9. Security and defense, professional direction 9.1 "National security" ("Migration processes and risks for national security" (In the context of cybersecurity and information security), announced in the State Gazette No. 49/17.06.2025
